Argentinian lawyer and politician. He has been a public servant his whole life. In 2002, amidst one of the most important crisis in his country, he was elected President of the Nation by the Legislative Assembly. Duhalde chaired the Commission of MERCOSUR's Permanent Representatives between 2003 and 2005. He is the author of various publications and articles on Argentina's social and productive development. He is presently President of the Argentinian Productive Movement (Movimiento Productivo Argentino, MAP), which is a non-partisan institution created in 2001 for the development and dissemination of productive ideas.
